
Lungle Paradise

About our classes & camps

classes

Summer are open to members and non-members from 6 months to 4 years old kids. Classes are limited to 8 kids each on a first paid first served basis.

For classes, each child must be accompanied by an adult who is allowed to have as much fun in the class as their little ones. We do not offer refunds for classes once purchased, but will be happy to offer a make-up class within the current timetable, subject to availability, if you let us know in time before the class that you are unable to attend at least 24 hours.

camps

Camps are open to members and non-members and are for 3-8 years old kids. Camps are drop-off style, snacks and lunch are provided.

Our super camps can get a little messy, so please make sure your little ones wear old clothes and socks. Please let us know of any allergies or medical conditions of you little ones in advance.

*Outing:

Please be advised that advance booking is mandatory for the outing to Pok Fu Lam by June 29. For the visit to Stanley Market, advance booking is required at least 3 days prior. The outing fee is not included in the camp fee; an additional fee of \$200 is required, which covers one child and one accompanying adult. In the event of light rain, the outing will proceed as planned. However, if adverse weather conditions arise, Kindhood will determine whether to reschedule the outing for another day within the camp week or to offer alternative themed camp activities at the club based on weather conditions.
